**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BEACHWOOD, OCEAN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY
ESTABLISHING A LENGTH OF SERVICE AWARD PROGRAM FOR MEMBERS OF THE
BEACHWOOD FIRST AID SQUAD AS SPONSORING AGENCY AND IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE
BOROUGH OF PINE BEACH**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Beachwood, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of the within Ordinance is to establish the Length of Service Award Program for the Beachwood First Aid Squad. The Beachwood First Aid Squad serves the Borough of Pine Beach, as well as Beachwood, and contributions will be established on the basis of 70% for Beachwood and 30% for Pine Beach. The program is to reward members of the Beachwood Volunteer First Aid Squad for the years of loyal and devoted service to the residents of the Borough of Beachwood and additionally the Borough of Pine Beach.

SECTION 2. The LOSAP shall provide for fixed annual contributions to the deferred income account for each member of the Beachwood First Aid Squad that meets the criteria set below. Such contribution shall be made in accordance with a plan that shall be established by the sponsoring agency Borough of Beachwood which shall be identical to a similar plan to be adopted by the Borough of Pine Beach and it shall be serviced by a single contractor. The plan shall be administered in accordance with the Laws of the State of New Jersey, the U.S. Internal Revenue Code and this sub-section. Said initial plan point system is attached hereto as Schedule A.

SECTION 3. The length of LOSAP shall provide for annual contributions to each eligible member that meets the criteria as follows:

- a. The annual contribution shall be seven hundred and fifty (\$750.00) dollars per eligible member per qualifying year.
- b. The estimated cost of the program annually has been calculated as follows:
$$50 \text{ members} \times \$750.00 \text{ per member} = \$37,500.00$$

Prorated on the basis of 70% responsibility to Beachwood and 30% responsibility to Pine Beach
- c. A minimum of 50 points per year must be earned in order to qualify for the LOSAP program.
- d. The point system hereby established is attached hereto as Schedule "A".

SECTION 4. This Ordinance repeals any inconsistent ordinance or ordinances or

part or parts thereof.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law and further conditioned upon the adoption of a similar Ordinance by the Borough of Pine Beach. Additionally, subsequent to the adoption of the within Ordinance and an Ordinance by Pine Beach it shall not take effect until it is presented as a public question for the voters of both Municipalities at the next general election.

TRAINING COURSES

One (1) point applied for each verified one hour of Instruction/training, 20 POINTS MAX

DRILLS

One (1) point per drill attended. A drill must have an attendance of a minimum of one-third (1/3) of the active membership in order to qualify for the point validation 15 POINTS MAX .

MEETINGS

One (1) point per first aid monthly or special meeting attended 05 POINTS MAX

FIRST AID CALLS

A_ Must be in Physical attendance to receive credit

B. The following formula will be used to Determine point total.

1. 50 divided by the total number of calls available
2. Times the number of calls actually attended
3. Equal the number of points applied

COMPANY FUNCTIONS

1. Any active member who becomes temporarily disabled
