

ORDINANCE 2014-09

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BEACHWOOD, OCEAN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURES FOR LANDFILL CLOSURE, AND RELATED EXPENSES AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$60,108.56 FROM THE RESERVE FOR LANDFILL CLOSURE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Beachwood,

County of Ocean and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The improvements described in Section 2 of this Ordinance are hereby authorized to be undertaken by the Borough of Beachwood, in the County of Ocean and State of New Jersey. For said improvements as stated in Section 2, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$ which appropriation has been made available from the Beachwood Borough Capital Fund Reserve for Landfill Closure.

SECTION 2. The description of the improvement required is a follow:

<u>Improvement</u>	<u>Appropriation</u>
Landfill Closure and Related Expenses	\$ 60,108.56

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final adoption as provided by said Local Bond Law.
